

Dear Brother Knights:

I have been asked again to Chair the C&B program for Council 207. The C&B (Charitable & Benevolent) fund can be a great way for Council 207 to raise money for our charitable donations. Every book we sell for \$13.00 we get to keep \$6.00 and \$1.00 for Tyburn Academy, who fills out the books for you. We have over nine hundred members; if each member purchased ONE book we would make \$5,400. We sold 285 books last year, to 157 members which brought in \$1,705.00 and \$285.00 for Tyburn. Out of the \$1,705.00 we needed to pay for the mailing and postage which was over \$400.00. So this year we are including the coupon and letter in our monthly bulletin for September, saving the cost of a mailing. We hope that you will fill out the coupon and mail it to the council, or just bring it in and drop it off. Individual tickets are also available at the Council. The prizes for the raffle are as follows: Grand prize \$25,000.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$10,000.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$5,000.00 and 10 prizes of \$1,000.00. We would like to make this a successful fundraiser for the Knights of Columbus this year and appreciate any support in purchasing books.
